HEARING FOR TIGHT ENDS SPORTSBAR AND GRILL UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REMERTON TO SHOW CAUSE WHY THEIR LICENSE SHOULD NOT BE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED OR REVOKED FOR FAILURE TO FILE QUARTERLY REPORTS AND FAILURE TO INSTALL SECURITY CAMERAS AS REQUIRED.

Patricia Allen stated that cameras are installed in her place and that her quarterly reports were turned in two days late due to her husband being ill in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Chief Mike Terrell told Mayor and Council that the City Clerk sent out reminder letters to all establishments in regards to quarterly reports and that he had personally given her a notice. He also stated that officers had checked her business two times but cannot get retrievable images from the equipment. He also stated he has numerous problems from the past with Mrs. Allen and can provide the documents if Mayor and Council would like them. Ms. Allen stated the officers are hurting her business because officers are always in front of her establishment but the Chief stated that is central location for them so that they can get to each end of the street when needed. She then stated that she had several break-ins and that the police did not do anything about it and that the cameras showed nothing. Chief Terrell then stated it was found to be her son that was breaking in. Attorney Brad Folsom questioned Ms. Allen in regards to the first quarter report and the amount she reported as revenue. He questioned the amount of her electric bill and other expenses. She stated she paid most of the bills from her own account and that her employees were paid by tips only. Council member Wetherington stated she had 6 months and 2 weeks to have equipment installed and working and that it is for the safety of her employees and customers that she has the equipment working. Council member Day stated she felt the license should be suspended until they have a chance to review the case. She stated that the previous City Manager and the City Clerk had offered to help her fill out the programs. Ms. Allen stated she had to run the report daily and weekly and compile report. Council member Wood asked if she could run a monthly report on her current software. She stated no. Council member Day made motion to suspend the license until next regular meeting on August 10, 2009 which was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Stacks. All in favor. Motion carried.
